She was preceded in death by her husband, Robert on July 17, 2002.

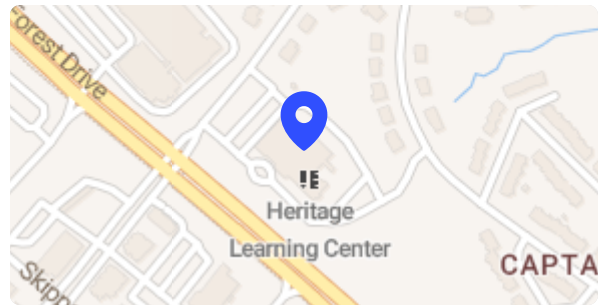
