Gail Ellen Diamond of Millersville, MD died at the Anne Arundel Medical Center, Annapolis, MD on Thursday, March 31, 2011. She was 57.

Born March 13, 1954 in Brooklyn, NY, she was the daughter of the Warren and Dorothy Coffill Ballenberger. She was a graduate of Montgomery Blair High School in the Class of 1972 and in 1980 she was a graduate of the University of Maryland Dental School in Baltimore. 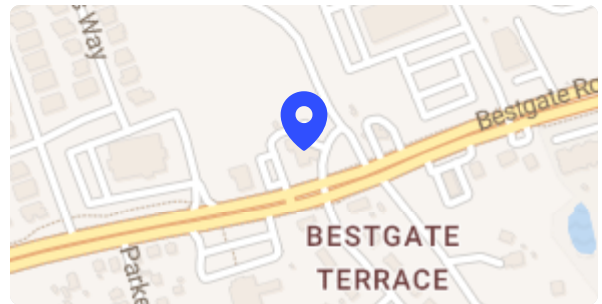

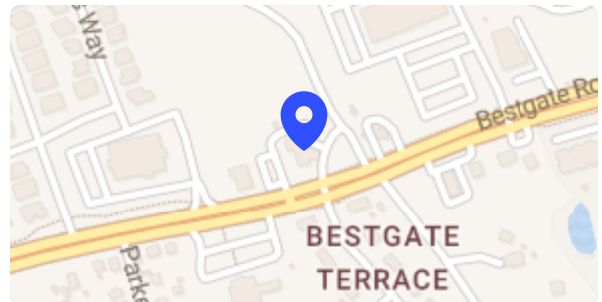

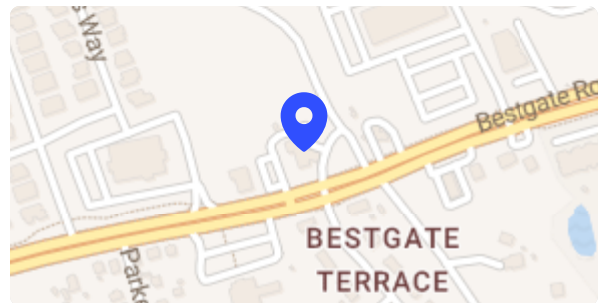
