A service will be held immediately following at 11am. Burial will take place at Bestgate Memorial Park, 814 Bestgate Road Annapolis, MD 21401.






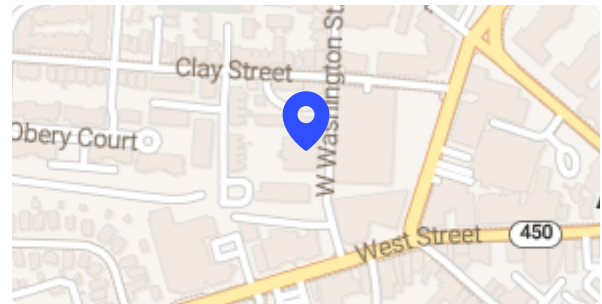

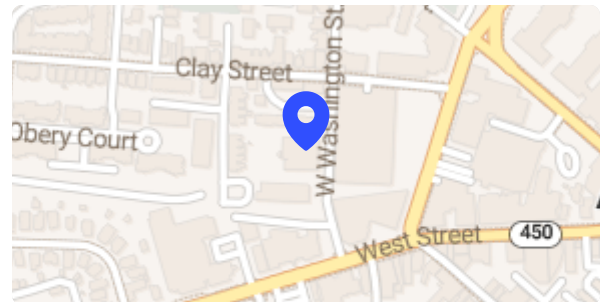

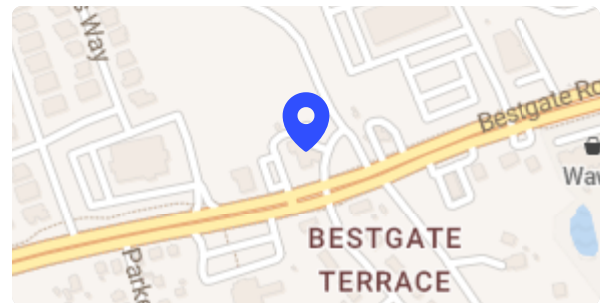
