Lula departed this life Friday, October 10, 2014 at Mandrin Inpatient Care Center in Harwood, Md. surrounded by her children.



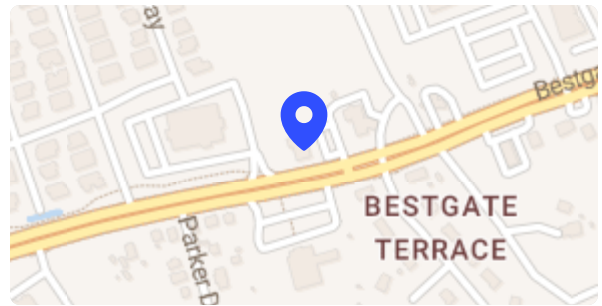
