Janie M. Ballard Sandle of Gambrills, MD, the beloved daughter of Patsie and the late Willie L. Ballard, Sr., transitioned from this life on October 14, 2014. Janie wore many hats as wife, daughter, mother, sister, grandmother, friend, and colleague.

Janie was born on July 7, 1943 in Scotland Neck, North Carolina and was baptized at Crowell's Baptist Church in Halifax, NC. She was also baptized in the Jordan River in the Holy Land. Janie attended school in the Halifax County School System and graduated from the Annapolis Continuing Education Program.

Forty-one years ago, Janie married Jesse Sandle, Sr., they were wed on September 29, 1973. She was employed and retired from the Navy Resale System after 25 years of service. After retiring, she became co-owner of the Watch Tune Up, Inc.

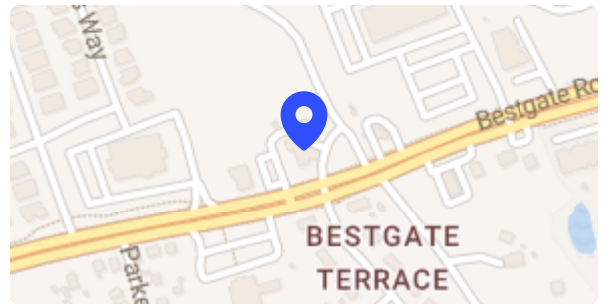

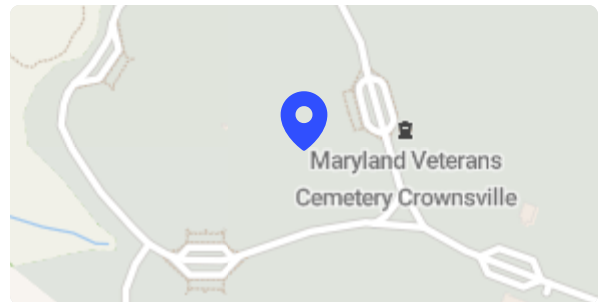
