## **Robert Markee Creager**

**R**obert Markee Creager passed away Thursday, June 9 in Baltimore, MD. He was 93.

Born March 21, 1918, he was the son of George L. Creager Jr. of Hanover, PA and Elizabeth S. (Mount) Creager of Donegal Bay, Ireland. He graduated from William Penn High School in Harrisburg, PA in 1936. He became employed at Bendix Radio Division Towson, MD, where he worked for 45 years. On July 12, 1942 he married Dorothy Jane (Dietrich) Creager of Steelton, PA. She preceded him in death on October 12, 1991.

Bob was very proud, private, quiet, and organized. He enjoyed gardening, dancing with Dorothy, and eating crabs. He also spent many hours searching family Genealogy. He enjoyed tennis, and he played so that he made all the other players do the running. He always enjoyed building electronics such as radios, TV's, and color TV's.
