A reception will take place immediately following the service at the church.

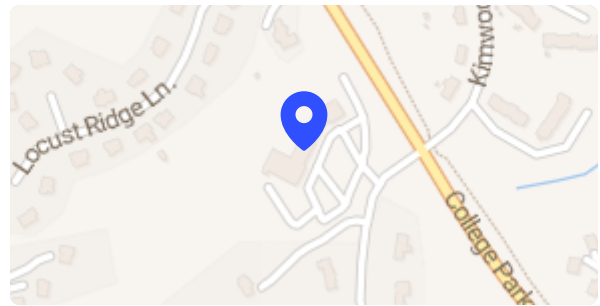
