She received her early education at the Heritage Learning Center and the Book of Life Academy. She furthered her education in the Anne Arundel County Public Schools and attended Annapolis Middle School and graduated from Annapolis Senior High School in 2001. She continued her education and matriculated through Morgan State University and received her bachelor's degree in Family Consumer Sciences. She also attended the University of Maryland and University of Notre Dame, where she received her master's degree in Elementary Education. She was currently employed with the Anne Arundel County Public Schools as a first grade teacher at the Pershing Hill Elementary School in Fort Meade, MD.

She was a lifetime member of Cecil Memorial United Methodist Church and served as the President of the Communion Stewards, Superintendent of Sunday School, Vacation Bible School teacher, and was a member of the Young Adult Ministry. She was also a member of A Tribute to Women of Color.
