Rose was educated through the Anne Arundel County Public School system and graduated from Annapolis High School in 1976. While in high school she worked at Gino's and Arinc through the work study program. She enjoyed working because she enjoyed money and being independent. After high school she gained employment through the social security department where she did clerical duties.

In 1983, Rose met the love of her life, Stafford Alexander Jr. of Orange, Texas. They were later married and moved to Nuremburg, Munich, Germany where Stafford was stationed by the Army. This matrimony blessed Rose with her first and only son, Stafford Alexander III in 1986. In 1987 Rose moved back to Maryland where she started working for the federal government on Fort Meade. 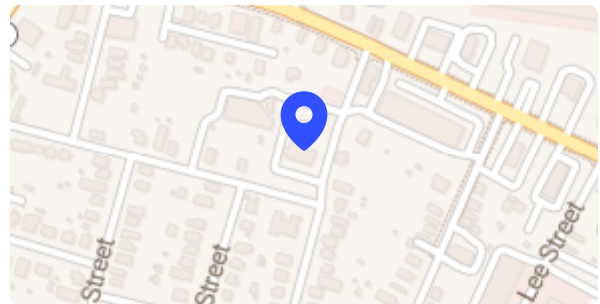

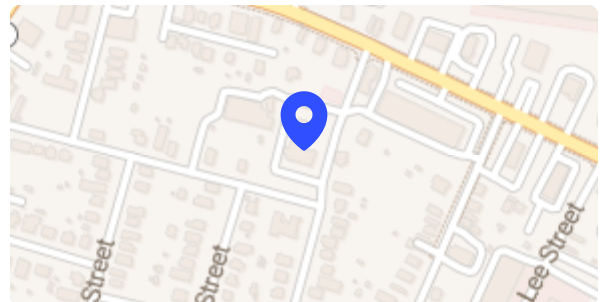

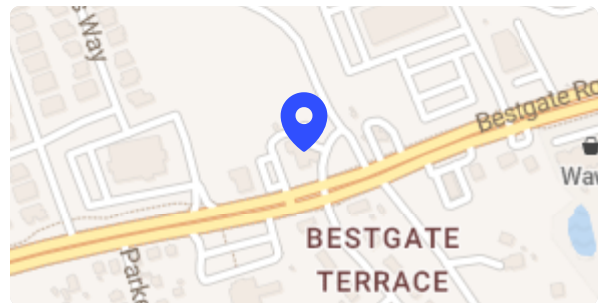
