Joseph Frederick Smith, known to family and friends as “Joe, JFred, or Freddie,” passed away on April 22, 2020, in Annapolis, Maryland. He was born on July 18, 1945, in Baltimore. He was raised in Annapolis and attended Wiley H. Bates High School for his freshman and partial sophomore years. He spent his youthful summers working at a hot dog stand at the family-owned Carr’s Beach. In 1963, he graduated from St. Emma Military Academy in Powhatan, Virginia. After graduation, he enlisted in the United States Air Force (USAF). During his service, he lived in Alaska, Arizona, California, and Germany. He proudly served in the USAF for 23 years and retired at the rank of Senior Master Sergeant.

Joseph touched everyone who knew him. He will be remembered for his wisdom, sense of humor, kindness, compassion, positivity, and his pulled pork barbecue. He enjoyed spending time with family and friends, playing solitaire, going to musicals, reading and watching the news, completing crossword puzzles, shopping on Amazon, and watching sports—especially “his son” Tiger Woods and his unflinching belief in and love for tennis G.O.A.T. Serena Williams. He also did not meet a television drama that he did not love.
