Peggy Ann White, age 77, died of complications caused by Parkinson's disease on October 20, 2021, in Annapolis, Maryland. Peggy is survived by her son, Michael White, of Clarksburg, West Virginia, her daughter, Kathleen White, of Edgewater, Maryland, and her daughter, Nancy White, of Woodbridge, Virginia. She is also survived by her grandchildren, Grace and Gabriella White, of Woodbridge, Virginia, her brother Rev. James Shields of Camp Hill, Pennsylvania, her brother Louis Nyecki and sister Anne Gagne, along with several nephews, nieces, and extended family. Peggy was preceded in death by her husband, Joseph White, on November 8, 2013, and her parents, John Shields and Harriet Nyecki.

Peggy was born and raised in Jersey City, New Jersey, and graduated from Henry Snyder High School in 1963. After graduation, she worked for several years in New York City as a telephone operator. 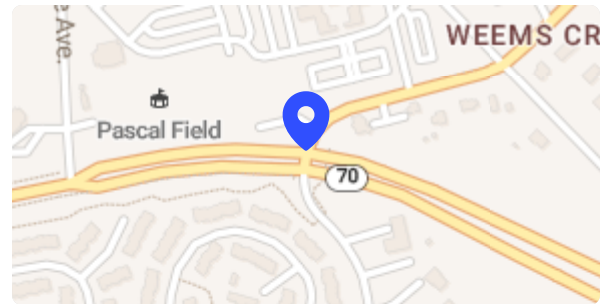

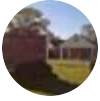
