Ann T. Murray of Chevy Chase, MD and Annapolis, MD, passed away peacefully on January 9, 2022. Ann was born in Washington, DC., on April 25, 1926 to Charles and Eleanor Maloney. She was the fifth of eight children, all of whom predeceased her. She was devoted to her family and to Blessed Sacrament Church and Parrish where she attended school and ultimately married her husband, Joseph L.B Murray there in 1949. Her lifelong devotion to Blessed Sacrament Church was instrumental to Ann as she raised her six children: J. Burt Murray., Joanne Murray Hill, Mary T. 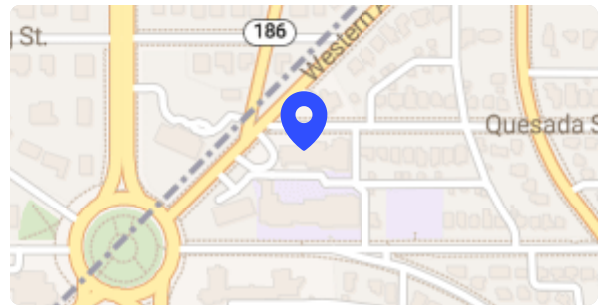

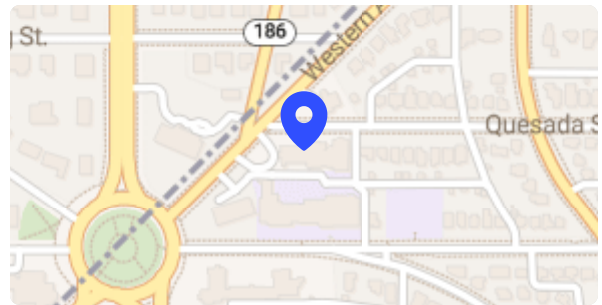

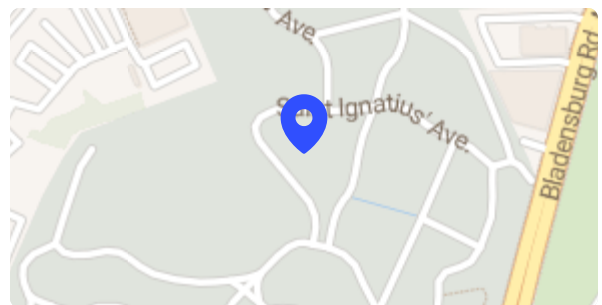
