Audrey Louise Batchelor passed away on April 21, 2022, in Annapolis, Maryland at the age of 85.

Audrey was born on July 9, 1936, in the District of Columbia to Helen and Hugh Frain. After attending the Washington School for Secretaries, she started her first job with the Army Security Agency as a GS-05 Secretary, kick-starting a career serving the country she loved.

Audrey retired from the Department of Defense in 1997 after 40 years of service. She was happily married to her best friend, William Batchelor, for 39 years.

Audrey was a beloved wife, cousin, 'Aunt' to so many, and friend who loved to play bingo at the local Moose Lodge, read, play cards, and spend time crafting. Some of her most cherished memories and friends were made boating along the East Coast with friends and family.

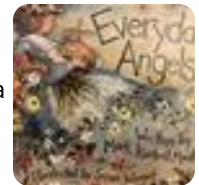

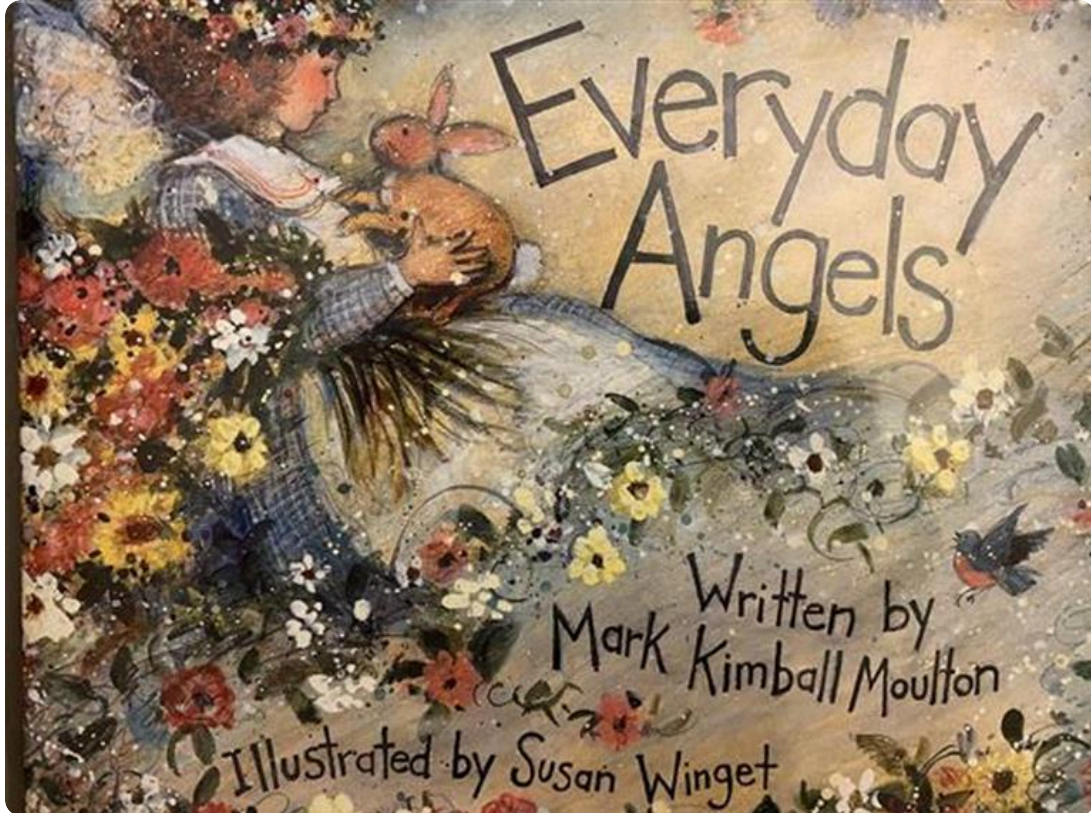
