As well as a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.



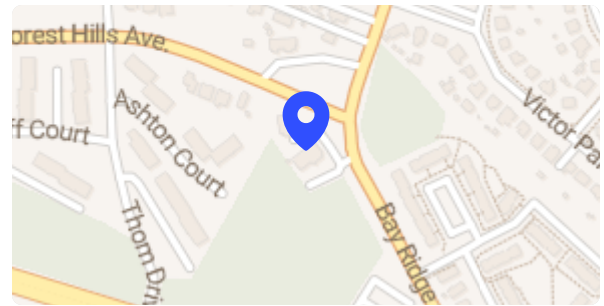

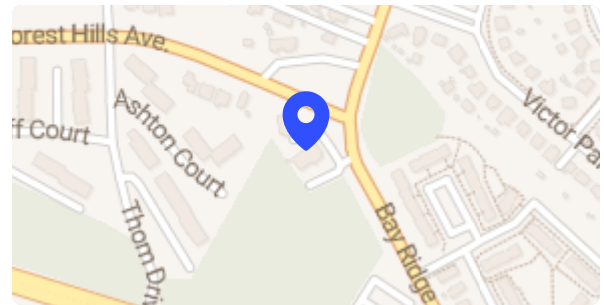

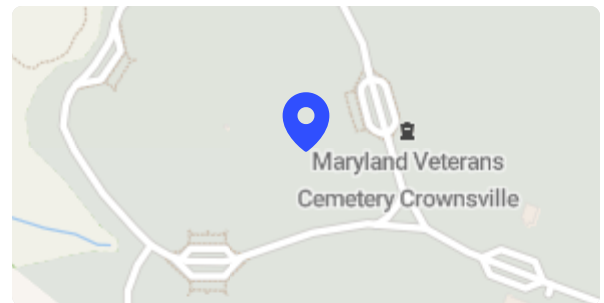
