# Raymond Eugene Gibson

DEC 28, 1932 - AUG 10, 2022

**R**aymond Eugene Gibson, 89 passed away on Wednesday, August 10, 2022 in his favorite place, his home in Annapolis, Maryland on the Little Magothy River surrounded by his loved ones. Raymond was born December 28, 1932 in Roanoke, Virginia and was a proud southern gentleman. He graduated from Virginia Polytechnical Institute then joined the United States Army and fought during the Korean War. He later volunteered to go to Vietnam during the Vietnam War as a civilian in the beginning of his 30 plus years of service with the Federal Government.

Raymond was preceded in death by his wife Mary Helen Gibson and his eldest son Scott Eugene Gibson. He is survived by his children Glynis Anne Gibson and her husband Scott, Laura Mae Gibson- Degler and her husband Douglas, Joseph Kelly Eugene Gibson and his wife Gwen, Lee Meredith Eugene Gibson and his wife Kerrileigh, his 6 grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren and his girlfriend of 8 years, Maureen Lombardo.

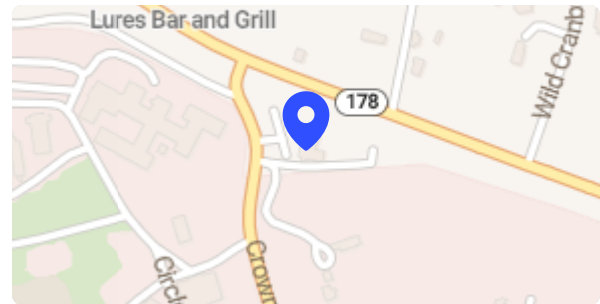

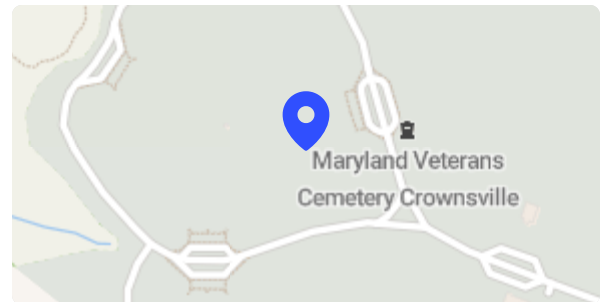
