In addition to his Naval career, he proudly served on the Annapolis City Police force for 25 dedicated years.

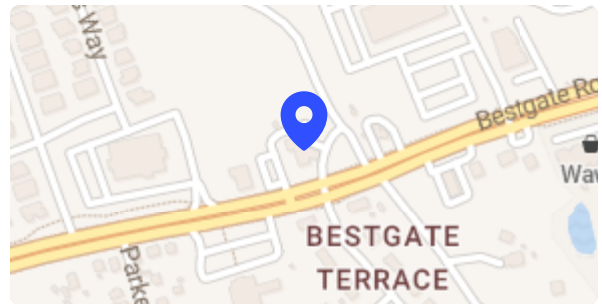

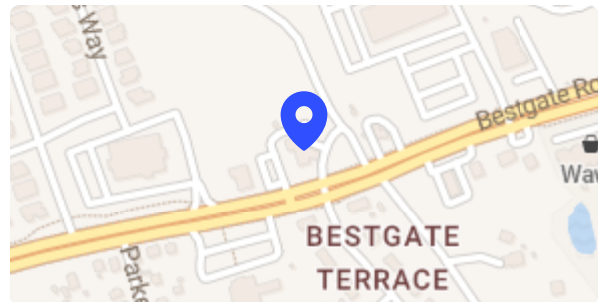
