Helen "Boots" Raglin, 85, a resident of Stevensville, MD for 40 years and prior to that Glen Burnie, MD passed away Saturday, October 8, 2022 at Regency Park Assisted Living in Gambrills, MD. She was born in Baltimore, MD on November 21, 1936, and born to and raised by her mother Eleanor Potee.

Helen was a "people person" through and through. Her devotion to people and community afforded her many positions which include a cashier, a school bus driver, in addition to holding customer service and sales positions in the airfreight transportation industry. Finally, she concluded her career with employment at the Commissioner's office in Queen Anne's County before retiring in March 2011.

She was very much involved with the local chapter of the Red Hat Society, namely the Queen Anne Bay Ladies of Stevensville, MD and held the distinct honor as "Queen" of their local chapter for quite some time.
