Margaret Grace Black was born on December 10, 1944. She was one of fourteen children born to the late Daniel Nathaniel Randall, Sr. and Mary Virginia (Hall) Randall. Margaret passed away peacefully on January 9, 2023.

She received her education in the Anne Arundel County Public Schools. She worked as a housekeeper and Nurse's Aide for the elderly, something she really loved.

Margaret dedicated her life to Jehovah God and was baptized on February 17, 1973 along with her sisters, Carrie and Mary. She served as a regular pioneer for over ten years. Although completely bedridden later in life, she continued to tell others about Jehovah and enjoyed being able to see her spiritual family whether in person before the pandemic or by Zoom during the pandemic.
