He was an educator, and his career included the Anne Arundel County Public School System and the Baltimore County Public School System. William was a member of Hope St. Mark United Methodist Church. In earlier years he was a Sunday School teacher. He enjoyed reading the Bible, the Upper Room book, listening to gospel music and playing games on his iPad.

William was a very generous person. He would give his last dime to anyone. He loved talking on the phone, which he did for hours at a time. As soon as he finished one conversation, he would immediately dial another number. He cherished his niece, nephew, great nieces and nephews. He was always inquiring about their position on their jobs, their grades in school and what classes they were taking in college. He wanted to know the whole ten yards. 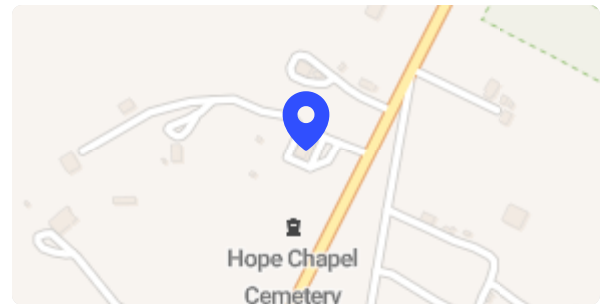

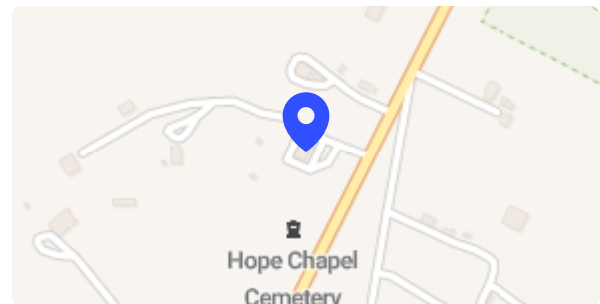

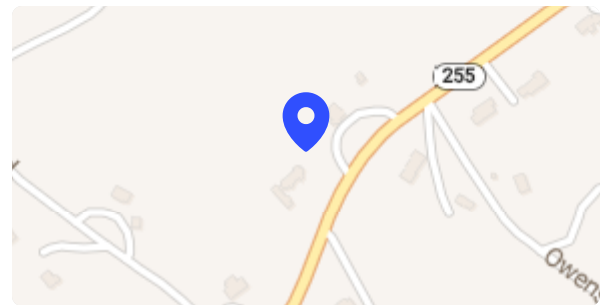
