Jacqueline Marie Gage (Soucy), 79, passed away at home with her loving family on Saturday, November 18, 2023, after a yearlong battle with cancer. Jackie had previously fought and won two bouts of breast cancer.

Jackie was born on August 4, 1944, the daughter of Edouard Soucy and Georgette Soucy (Dallaire). Jackie attended parochial schools in Manchester, NH and spoke both French and English. Jackie met her husband, Frederick John Gage, through her brother, Edgar and fell in love. They were married for 44 adventurous years.

The family lived in many beautiful cities, throughout their marriage, finally settling in Arnold, MD. Along the way, Jackie made many friends who became like family, most notably the Lord, Tempestilli, Dove and Geithner families. 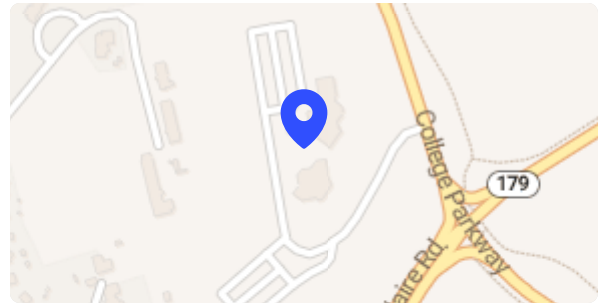
