Linda was a very outgoing and friendly person and was liked by all who knew her.

Linda enjoyed spending time with her late mother, Thelma, as she was the only girl in a family of three brothers. She also enjoyed times with her nieces and nephews. She especially enjoyed times with her sister-in-law, Lanoria, and her husband, Charles Black. Linda and Lanoria grew up together like sisters and partied and danced the nights away as young women.
