# Robert Camille Houlne

**R**obert (Bob) Camille Houlne of Millersville, MD quietly passed away at his home on December 25, 2023, with his family by his side.

Bob was born in Manchester, New Hampshire on May 3, 1936, the son of John and Christine Houlne. Bob attended Manchester High School Central. Afterwards, he went on to earn his Bachelor of Science Degree in Electrical Engineering at the University of New Hampshire which led to his 26-year career as an Electrical Engineer at Westinghouse in Maryland. 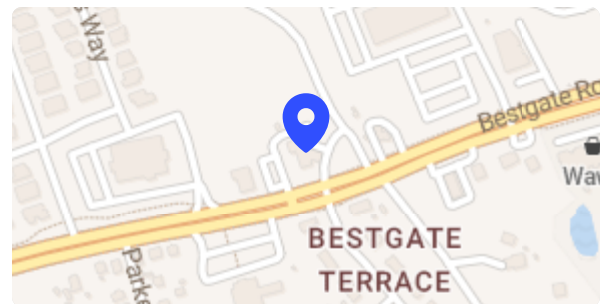

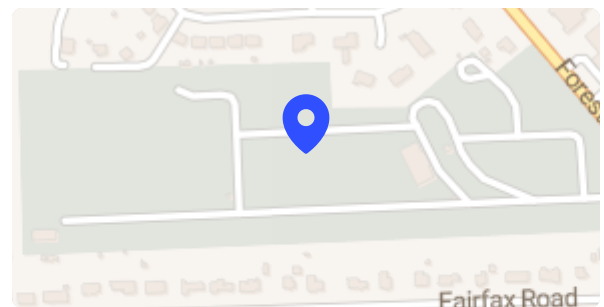

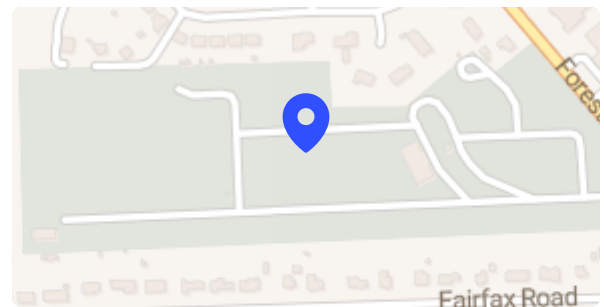
