**J**ames Allen Amos Sr. (Sonny), 84, passed away the morning of January 29, 2025. James (Sonny) was born in Annapolis, Maryland on September 6, 1940 to parents Thomas Edward Amos and Anna Kathryn Amos (Tolson). James (Sonny) attended high school in Annapolis, Maryland. He served in the United States Army, and upon completion of his service, attended the Police Academy. He then worked as a police officer for the Annapolis City Police Department for a time, before working as a home improvement contractor until retirement. While working as a contractor, James also had his real estate license and worked with Glenco Realty and Champion Realty in Annapolis. He loved his dogs and his family, and he found enjoyment in crabbing, NASCAR races, travel, and classic car shows. He was a lifetime member of the Moose, Elks, and the American Legion.

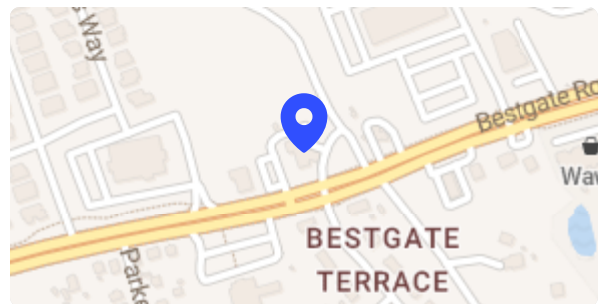

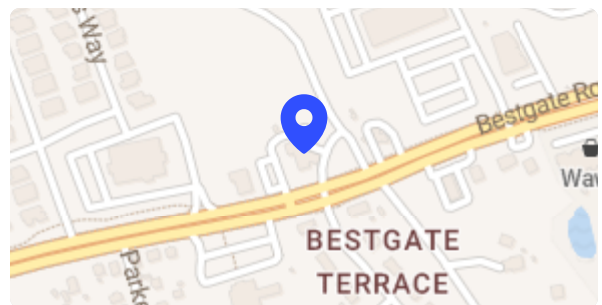

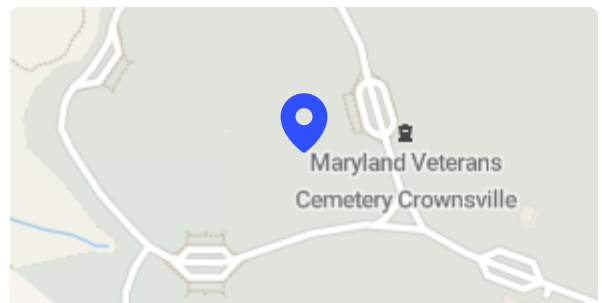
