Mack's legacy of love, laughter, and loyalty will live on through those who knew him best. Though he is gone, his memory will forever shine bright in our hearts.






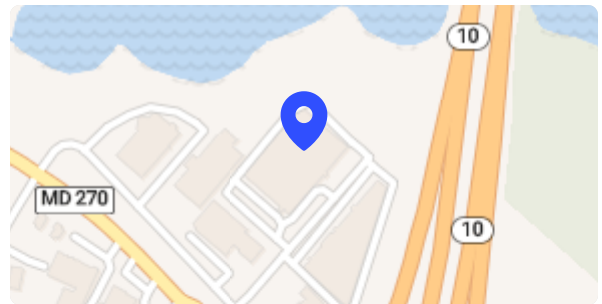
