Harry, better known as "Bug," was born on May 24, 1948, to the late Harry W. Walker Jr. and Florene Carr. Harry was educated in the public school system of Anne Arundel County. He went to Adams Park Elementary School and was a graduate of Bates High School, the class of 1966.

He went on to attend Bowie State College. After college, Harry held employment at various places including the U.S. Naval Academy and U.S. Postal Service. Harry also, had the honor of serving in the U.S. Army During the Vietnam War from 1968 to 1970.

Bug enjoyed the Spa Road cook outs. He was an adoring sports fan, especially to the Baltimore Ravens and the NBA. He truly cherished spending time with family and friends. He loved playing cards with the fellows and was always ready to help anyone in need.
