# Jesse Burnett Robinson

**A**fter a life well lived, Jesse B. Robinson, affectionately known as “JR,” passed away peacefully at home on the evening of February 22, 2026. Our Heavenly Father gently guided him home to eternal rest.

Jesse was born on May 31, 1953, in Edgewater, Maryland, to Jesse and Catherine Robinson. At an early age, he accepted Christ as his Lord and Savior and remained steadfast in his faith throughout his life. He was a devoted member of Chews United Methodist Church in Harwood, Maryland, where he faithfully served on the Trustee Board.

He was educated in the Anne Arundel County Public School System and graduated with the Class of 1971 from Southern Senior High School in Harwood, Maryland. Following graduation, Jesse embraced his entrepreneurial spirit by founding JBR Trucking Company. He later dedicated over 20 years of service to Anne Arundel County Public Works. 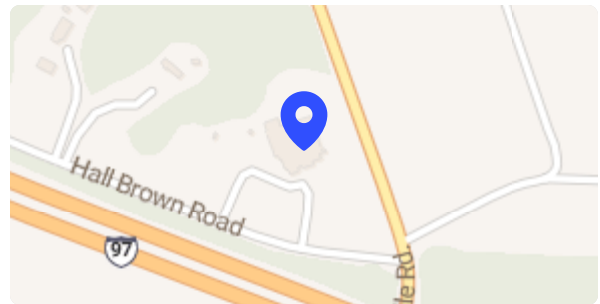

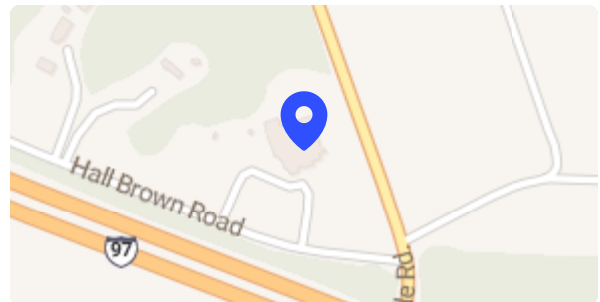

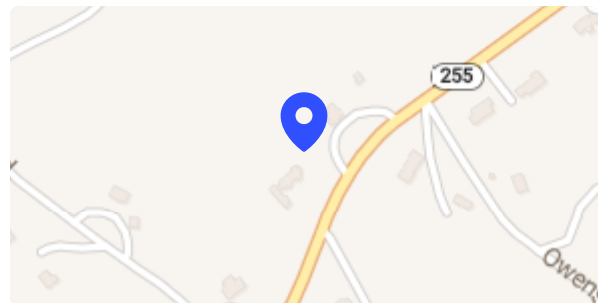
